Subject: Legislative Priorities

Town Manager and Town Council,

I would like to suggest the following for inclusion in Los Gatos' Legislative Priorities for this year. The following is quoted from a press release on the three bills. They are being run as a bill package.

Artificial Intelligence + Elections Bill Package:

- **SB 1228 from Senator Steve Padilla.** Gives social media users more information about the anonymous trolls and disinformation spreaders with the largest followings and the most power to make disinformation go viral.
- **AB 2839 from Assemblymember Gail Pellerin.** Keeps misleading deepfakes out of campaign ads and independent expenditures close to Election Day, protecting candidates and elections officials.
- **AB 2655 from Assemblymember Marc Berman.** Combats online disinformation regarding elections by labeling generative AI deepfakes, and restricting the most pernicious and obvious of them close to Election Day.
